## (H3 FOCUS: GENESIS 3



Dear God, help us to see Adam and Eve's sin in the garden, and to learn from it. Help us to flee temptation, and to be mindful of where we are tempted. May we stand firm in your strength and in your perfect obedience. In Jesus's name, Amen

ASK, "WHAT IS ONE THING YOU LEARNED ON SUNDAY?"

SAY SOMETHING LIKE, "I LEARNED \_\_\_\_\_ AND THE LORD IS TEACHING ME TO \_\_\_\_\_."

ASK, "HOW CAN YOU TAKE WHAT YOU LEARNED AND USE IT THIS WEEK TO GIVE GOD GLORY?

Fun Time! Consider connecting a fun activity you do as a family to this week's passage.

- Example: play a game of tag as a family.
- Take time to consider how as Christians, we must flee temptation!

ENJOY A MEAL AROUND THE TABLE WITH NO PHONES/TV. ASK TO HEAR STORIES ABOUT THE DAY. LISTEN AND ENJOY.

After dinner, read Genesis 3 together and use this questions to help discuss the passage together:

- What is Genesis 3 tell you about the serpent, who is later identified as Satan? What is he like? How does he work?
- What sins did Adam and Eve commit? How might we face the same Temptations?
- What are the effect of these first sins? What are the immediate and long-term impacts on procreation, marriage, work, and rest?
- Read the story of Jesus is temptation in the desert in Matthew 4:1-11. How is his response to temptation different than Adam and Eve's?
